

## Rudolf Steiner's Calendar of the Soul Verse 39: The Golden Verse

**Verse 39** relates to Spirit Man or Spirit Human, as yet our highest undeveloped spirit member, and to Condition 7, Intuition: "Unite all previous Conditions in our Living."

As at a physical birth when the soul awakens in the physical world, so in spirit birth our soul awakens each Christmas in the spiritual world. Soon at New Year's when the sound of the shepherds' golden music will have reached its peak and ebbs away, three new gifts are presented. We hear these in the three verses after Christmas as imaginatively the Three Kings present themselves: first the Golden Kings in Verse 39, then the Kings of Silver and Bronze in 40 and 41, each with his gift, in all, a new thinking, a new feeling, a new willing.


Devoted to the Spirit's revelation

During Summer and Autumn our forces were reorganizing our astral body, preparing us for a spiritual birth, a Spirit Revelation at Christmas. Now, in devoted surrender to understanding revelations of the Spirit, we gain a higher understanding, a higher thinking power and clarity that enable us to have a new sense, a new understanding of who we truly are —of our spiritual Self—now reborn before us.

Not intellectual, but higher, imaginative, warm thinking, is able to reveal to us a clearer sense of Self. At this time of year Heaven and Earth are in special union. With this new kind of understanding about the Self, we can more ably bring love into our actions as we move through Verses 40 and 41.

Beautifully Rudolf Steiner's *Gospel of St John*, in each lecture seems to reveal and illuminate Verse 39! In lecture two we are asked if from our inner being we can look into ourselves and see the Divine? The "Light of Cosmic Being" (true understanding) brings us this power. Without this perception of the divinity in the human being, the focus on our self would appear dark and empty, even as the world in mid-winter may appear to ordinary perception.


Surrendering to Spirit revelation in order to awaken true self-awareness is allowing my own thoughts to step aside so that I hear the Spirit speak to me. It is not a giving up. It is an act of will in which we give our earthly self over to the spirit in full trust. This trust opens us to the Christ Light and guidance in every step we need to take in order to live in this Light and shine it into our world.

This golden, "thinking" verse emphasizes our need for the power of thinking that gives understanding of esoteric concepts that help us to truly know ourself, to attain a clearer understanding of who we are and our part in the future. Integral to such understanding are of course a clear memory and a perceptive imagining. And these will play a significant part in the verses to come.

But something more is needed. This is the power of Christ, love of the good and the true, what the Spirit reveals to us. Rudolf Steiner's lecture six in the Hamburg cycle of St John lectures speaks of strength for our soul effort coming to us from the Christ, Who will enable us "by the forces of our own inner being" to have a consciousness of the Spirit of our Higher Self. With Christ given strength and our own true efforts, the soul can fulfill its need to gain this knowledge.

Our devoted surrender to the thoughts of the divine is giving us a new power of thinking by which in the verses from now to Easter we can find greater, deeper meaning. Our ego is given now a special capacity to remember and to reflect on what has been experienced. Astral pictures rise and pass away; but the ego uses etheric forces to remember and memory can be strengthened. From Christmas on, we can begin to waken this faculty —for new purposes.

Quite astonishingly, Lecture 6 of the John Gospel Hamburg lectures, even brings out the necessity, which eventually we shall understand, that is, to "remember" our past as far back as Saturn, Sun and Moon stages of Earth —even as Christ explains to Nicodemus that in future "except a man be born of water and air he cannot enter the kingdom of Heaven."

Future man, Rudolf Steiner reveals in stunning words, "must bear within him the consciousness that if he wishes to unite himself again consciously with the gods, his true existence will be in those regions from which he has sprung. He has become condensed out of water and air and he will again become diffused spiritually into them. He can only anticipate this condition today by gaining within his inner nature a consciousness of the future state of his physical body. Only by becoming conscious today that he will have this future state will he gain the power to attain it."

From the same lecture: [The human being] "will come again to a consciousness of the spirit through the force of the Christ Who appeared upon the earth. He will not only perceive in his physical environment with physical senses, but by means of the force of his own inner being of which he is now unconscious, a consciousness of his divine existence will flash up within him."

You may have sometime been surprised to find in Lecture 1 of the *World History* lectures given by Rudolf Steiner in the evenings of the Christmas Conference how much he talked about memory and

the three kinds going back to "old cosmic memory" and then of a new memory to come called "Spirit-Memory." We see this memory connection in the first stanza of *The Foundation Stone Mantra*, to "Practice Spirit-recollection In depths of Soul, Where in the wielding World-Creator-Life Thine own I Comes to being Within the I of God. Then in the All-World-Being of Man Thou wilt truly live."

How beautifully, then, Verse 39 connects to the John gospel lectures, to the *World History* lectures and to the great *Foundation Stone of Love*.

Today we can work to make ourselves conscious of what did happen in world evolution, in our own lives, and even to what is to happen. By "surrendering" our thinking to the Creative Spirit we can do this. We are in the Consciousness Soul Age, or Spiritual Soul Age, so with devoted attention an understanding of the nature of the cosmos and of the human self can come to us.

Indeed, we do need a clear power of thinking to reach higher understandings of the human I, as well as to purify lower aspects of the soul for the development of spiritual organs of perception. With humility the thinker's might must then give way to spiritual perceptions in order to bring to birth true self-awareness. From now on in the verses it will be fruitful to give more attention to our true inspirations and intuitions. (Valuable guidance in *The Background to the Gospel of St Mark*, Lecture 2.)

### Corresponding Calendar of the Soul Verses 14 and 39

In July, Verse 14, Ruth and Hans Pusch's translation, we see not "Surrendered to the spirit's revelation" as in this week's verse, but "Surrendering to senses' revelation." Does the soul thus appear weak in Verse 14? Without the guidance and leadership we're now experiencing, the Self appears to have been somewhat lost, or at least, greatly dimmed. For in summer the beauteous World does have strong attraction for the human being. But "cosmic thinking," do we remember what it was which we were to sense?

Much new awakening and ego strengthening occurs between Verse 14 and Verse 39!
